#### WORDS OF WISSDOM

The last several months have been a wild ride for me along with most of America or even the world. All the situations that have occurred from the continued engagement with the pandemic as well as the "normal" experiences of life from birth to death. As most all of you know my mother died last month after a whirlwind of four weeks of congestive heart failure with Afib. It just happened "so Fast" as one of my siblings describes it.

Mom died peacefully in hospice at the home she lived in for the last 50 some odd years surrounded by 7 of her children. She had time for goodbyes and joined my dad 3 days before their 68th-anniversary date. I had my parents many more years than my wife Cheryl who lost both hers at much younger ages. I've seen the loss she experiences on anniversaries and birthdays and sometimes for no reason. I empathized and comforted as best I could along our 35 years together. But now I relate. It's hard to describe the sense of loss of your parents. Many of you know what I am talking about. There is a void left behind that stands just beyond the reach of articulation.

The thing that empowers me and allows me to cope with the loss is my faith, our faith. Because of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection we know that we will one day be reunited with those that we have loved and who have gone before us to be in the presence of the loving God who created us in the first place. It's the grace of God that comforts you in so many ways, not the least of which has been you loving folks that call PUMC home. Thank you for your extravagant love and care for me and my family during this painful time. It has been an antidote to difficulty.

Another antidote for me, or a means of experiencing God's grace is the precious gift of being ordained and able to do baptisms. It seems no coincidence to me that the Sunday after my mother's death I was blessed to officiate at a beautiful little girls' baptism by the name of Charlotte Jae. The cycle of life was dancing with me that day as the seeming dichotomy of death and life enveloped me in God's love. Charlotte just seemed to innately know that her presence was important beyond normal human logic as I experienced sheer joy at the sacred moment we had together joined by the presence of her large and loving family!

It has been said that God moves in mysterious ways. I experienced one of those ways that day. My prayer for you is that you may recognize and embrace and experience one of those ways in your life soon. I am incredibly blessed to be with you on this journey!




