


The Missions "Mitten


If you haven't already done so, please return your pledge card - it isn't too late! Knowing what to expect, helps us to build a more realistic budget for 2020. Thank you!



The "Prayer Shawl and Prayer Pocket Square" Knitting Group has decided to change their meeting day. In January, 2020 they will begin


meeting on the second Monday of each month. Their first meeting of 2020 will be
